Having food stored, flashlights or medical supplies in the bathroom cabinet are all part of your preparations. This program intends to encourage you to be prepared to be self sufficient for 72 hours or more. No matter what the emergency is you can be better prepared than you are right now.

So with that said what's the difference between preparing for a Zombie attack and other type of emergencies?
